



HOUSING AND APARTMENTS

Long-term apartments are usually rented unfurnished, but they do include fitted kitchen cupboards, wardrobes, a refrigerator and a stove (often also a dishwasher). It is advisable to reserve enough time for looking for rented accommodation. Have a chat with your new local colleagues and/or friends for tips on shops and services, schools, childcare, etc.
